Devotional & Discussion Questions

THE POWER OF HIS PRESENCE

What I've always loved about Scripture is how God weaves His presence through every person and story, every chapter and verse. He is present and powerful in each book of the Bible, faithfully revealing His glory, lordship, and justice—as well as His mercy, compassion, and love for all of humanity.

One of the most intriguing books in the Bible is Esther, the Old Testament story of the Jewish girl who becomes the queen of Persia and is perfectly positioned to save the children of Israel from annihilation at the hands of an evil man. What is, perhaps, most fascinating is that while God is never directly mentioned throughout this riveting account of faith and courage, His presence is evident in the ways He works “behind the scenes” through altered circumstances, transformed hearts and minds, and the prevailing justice that paves the way for the deliverance of His people.

Dear friend, I want to encourage you that just like Esther, you can be assured that God is always present with you—even when He seems distant or absent—and He is always working for your good (Romans 8:28).

Wherever you find yourself in life today, take courage! God has promised He will never leave or forsake you (Hebrews 13:5). You can have perfect confidence that in every season and circumstance God is with you, God is for you, and God is in you. The power of God's presence makes all the difference!



Discussion Questions
